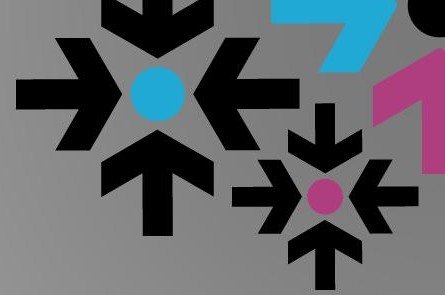
What kind of projects does ARIN fund?

 - Research



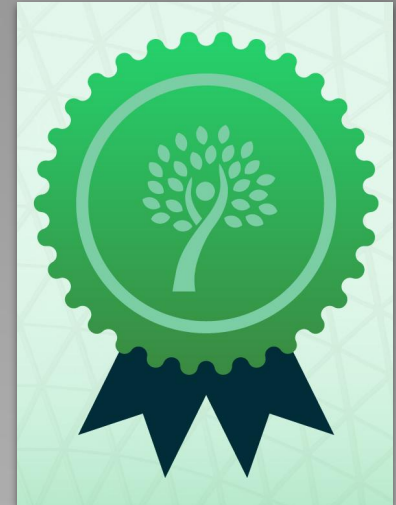

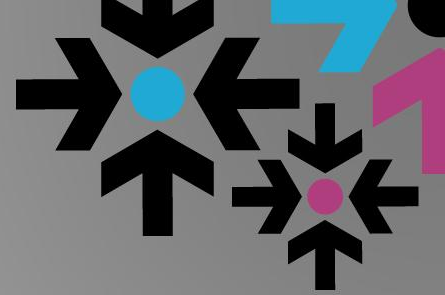

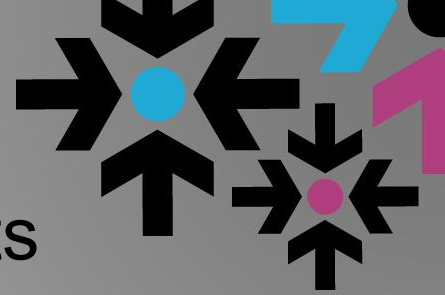
